Before joining CBIA, he served as the Vice President for the Personal Insurance Federation of California for the past 17 years; and prior to that, he served as the Managing Director for the Nehemiah Community Reinvestment Fund (NCRF), where he organized and facilitated millions in NCRF investments throughout California.
