CBIA President Dan Dunmoyer Named State Federation Champion by National Association of Home Builders

SACRAMENTO, CA - The [National Association of Home Builders](#) (NAHB) has honored Dan Dunmoyer, President and CEO of the [California Building Industry Association](#) (CBIA), as its 2025 State Federation Champion, one of the association's highest honors recognizing exceptional leadership and meaningful contributions to the homebuilding industry.

The Federation Champion Award recognizes the accomplishments of an outstanding executive officer who has contributed to the Federation during the prior calendar year. CBIA represents thousands of member companies encompassing every aspect of residential development, from land acquisition and design to construction and sales.

The son of a small home builder from Southern California, Dan Dunmoyer is widely recognized as a leading voice for the home building industry and as an expert in housing policy and California's legislative and regulatory process. He frequently serves as a lead negotiator on policies related to homebuilding and building requirements.

Dan Dunmoyer's background includes serving as President and CEO of the Personal Insurance Federation of California and as Senior Vice President and Head of Government Affairs for Zurich and Farmers Insurance companies. He previously served as Deputy Chief of Staff and Cabinet Secretary for Governor Arnold Schwarzenegger overseeing all state agencies for the Governor. Dan started his career as a Jessie Unruh Fellow in the California State Assembly, and went on to serve in various legislative caucus leadership and policy committee roles in the California Legislature.
